THE latest model in the popular Nova series, the Huawei Nova 2 Lite, is striking with a large screen housed in a compact body. The company used integrated design and has hidden the antenna to create a beautiful device with a sleek and slim body.

Its 5.99in HD FullView Display has a modern 18:9 screen ratio that cuts down on bezel size for a more immersive viewing experience.

The bigger screen also allows users to multitask to get more done with the smart spplitscreen feature.

And the 2.5D curved glass panel gives the phone a premium touch.

Despite the large screen, the Nova 2 Lite has a 5.5in tall body which makes it easy for the user to hold the phone and it can be used one-handed.

The smartphone is tough thanks to non-conductive metalisation (NCVM) coating applied to the device's frame, which not only results in a beautiful metal-like chrome finish but also makes it scratch resistant.

Dynamic dual camera

The Nova 2 Lite may be a mid-range model but it packs dual cameras, allowing it to take dramatic Bokeh images. The 13-megapixel camera is responsible for capturing a subject's details while the 2-megapixel sensor is for shooting photos with the Bokeh effect with seven levels of adjustment. There's no need to worry about getting a perfect shot, as the smartphone allows users to refocus the Bokeh after the photo is taken to produce portraits with striking details.

For even more fun, the AR Lens lets users change background and users' outfits with the Funny Cosplay feature. The back camera also supports this function.

of five precise optical lenses on the rear camera. This is combined with a blue glass IR filter to reduce falsified colours and ghost images, allowing users to take clearer and beautiful night view photos.

Superb selfies

The Nova 2 Lite's front camera is as impressive, with a 8-megapixel sensor with a wide-angle field of view of 77° to capture more scenery for selfies or more friends in a selfie.

The Selfie Toning Flash assists in making the subject look more natural and beautiful even in low-light environments by automatically detecting the lighting on the subject's face and intelligently adjusting the level of brightness. The function supports both manual and smart auto-adjustment.

And the Translucent Light Lampshade feature further rebalances the lighting to make the subject look more vibrant.

For the final touch, users are given 10 levels of adjustment for the beauty mode so they have more freedom in choosing the right



browsing photos or showing the notification panel.

Smarter experience

The phone runs on an octa-core Qualcomm Snapdragon 430 processor with 3GB RAM, and has 32GB

of storage. Memory space can be further boosted with a Micro SD card of up to 256GB in size.

Using Huawei's machine learning algorithms, the device learns the user's behaviours and habits to intelligently predict their needs for better mobile performance.

It's powered by the company's EMUI 8.0 user interface which uses next-gen file enhancement system to reduce file fragmentation, ensuring the smartphone performance stays speedy and responsive.

Users don't have to worry about their smartphone dying halfway through the day, as the Nova 2 Lite features a 3,000mAh battery capable of 13 hours of video playback or 58 hours of music.

The Power Saving 6.0 mode features eight solutions to reduce mobile power consumption, including detecting apps that are using up a lot of power.

The battery cell has an energy density of 650 WH/L with a life cycle of two years, ensuring it can maintain a charge of up to 80% even after two years.

At just RM799, it's one of the most affordable Androids that supports both VoLTE and VoWiFi calls, and has dual cameras and large 5.99in FullView Display.
